## Instructions for submitting a Medical Durable Power of Attorney (MDPoA)

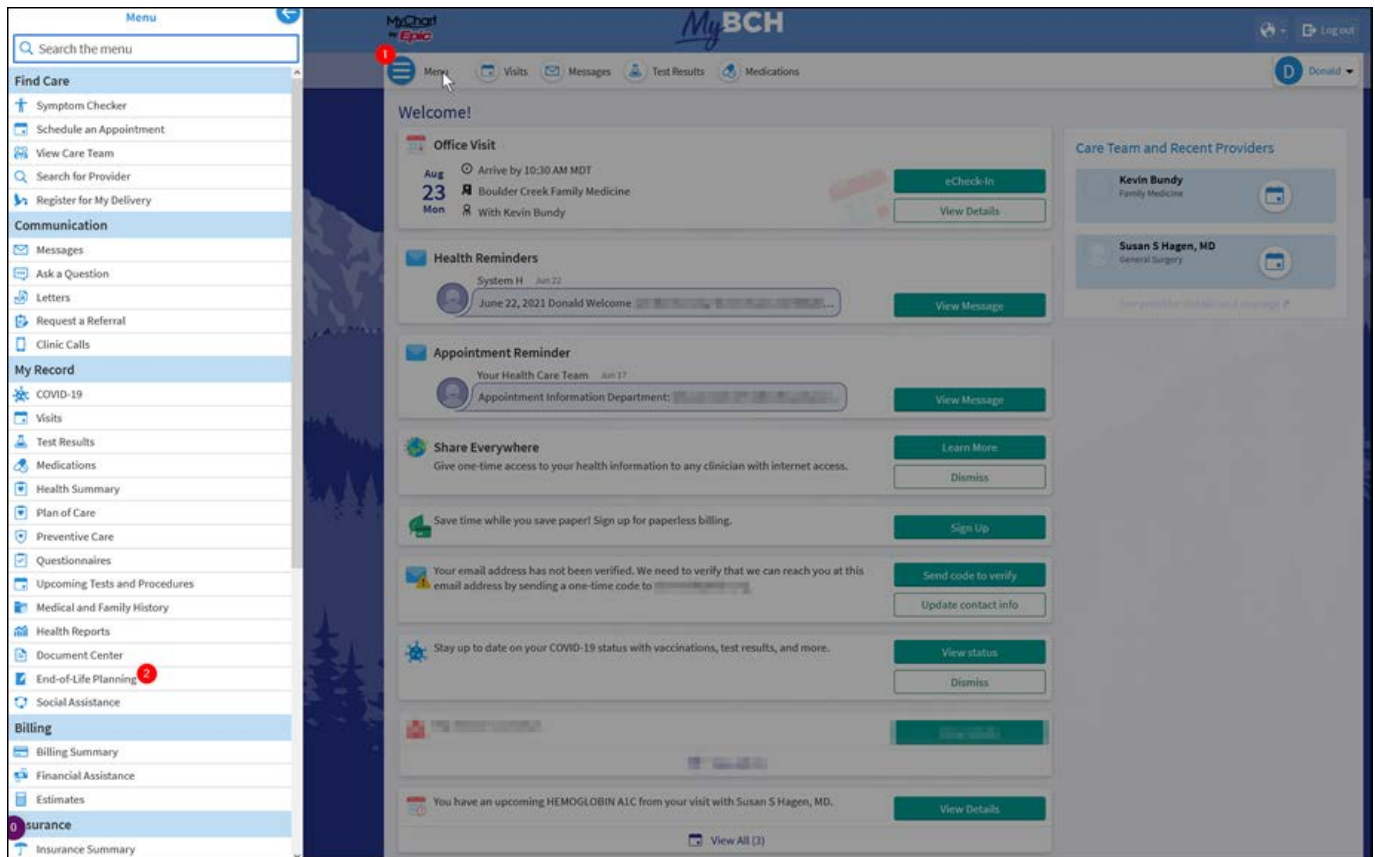
### Submitting a physical copy

Simply download a copy of the MDPoA form from the Advance Care Planning page and give it to your medical provider. It is recommended to save a copy for your personal records.

### Submitting an electronic MDPoA form via the MyBCH portal

There are two ways you can submit an electronic version of the MDPoA form.

**Option 1.** Download a copy of the form from the Advance Care Planning page to your computer. Log into your MyBCH patient portal, click "menu" and select End-of-Life Planning from the list. Once on this page, you can upload the MDPoA form to the documents section. See screenshots below.
