








Low Back Pain



- Very common condition
- Affects most people at some stage
- Many causes: arthritis, disc degeneration, infection, muscle strain, SI joint pathology, fracture, spondylolysis






Low Back Pain




Treatments:


- Ice, heat, physical therapy, cognitive behavioral therapy, NSAIDS, Tylenol, injections, ablation
- Surgery in the rare cases of instability, SI joint dysfunction



Radiofrequency Ablation (RFA)


for Pain Management








- Extrusion of disc material into the spinal canal
- Compresses the nerve in the canal or at the exit









- Can occur at any time
- May be associated with particular event (lifting something heavy, squatting), often no specific event recalled

Symptoms:


 Pain down one leg, numbness, tingling, weakness















Treatment:

- NSAIDS, PT, chiropractic, walking
- Epidural steroid injections
- Microdiscectomy Surgery: small window opened in the bone and the dura moved aside, disc fragment is removed












Lumbar Stenosis



- Narrowing of the lower spinal canal
- Causes pinching of the nerves to the legs

Symptoms:

- Pain down the legs, numbness, tingling
- Often occurs with walking any distance
- Feels better when sitting down or leaning forward




Lumbar Stenosis










Lumbar Stenosis



Treatment:

- PT, NSAIDS, epidural steroid injections
- Decompression surgery, decompression and fusion, interbody fusion
- Surgery to restore disc height, open the spine canal






- Narrowing of the lower spinal canal with slippage of vertebral body on another
- Causes pinching of the nerves to the legs
- Causes pinching of the nerves in the canal and often the foramen

Symptoms:


- Pain down the legs, numbness, tingling
- Often occurs with walking any distance
- Feels better when sitting down or leaning forward




Spondylolisthesis



SPONDYLOLISTHESIS








Treatment:

- PT, NSAIDS, epidural steroid injections
- Decompression surgery, decompression and fusion, interbody fusion
- Surgery to restore disc height, open nerve foramen, open the spine canal



























Adult Degenerative Scoliosis




- Degenerative curvature of the spine, usually lumbar spine
- More common in post-menopausal women
- Occurs due to asymmetric disc degeneration, disc collapse, facet arthritis, vertebral body collapse (from osteoporosis)

Symptoms:

 Feeling of imbalance, leaning forward, severe back pain, severe leg pain/numbness






Adult Degenerative Scoliosis



Treatments:

- Conservative: PT, NSAIDS, epidural injections, chiropractic, osteoporosis treatment
- Surgery: depends on the true origin.
- Everything from small decompression to large reconstructive surgery
- Surgery designed to restore alignment, improve balance, improve pain
